[ASSENTED TO 4TH OCTOBER, 1921.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and Legislative Assembly of Queensland in
Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Banana Industry* Short title.
Preservation Act of 1921."

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise indicates, Interpretation.
the following terms have the meanings respectively
assigned to them, that is to say:—

"Industry of the cultivation of bananas"—The
clearing or preparing of land for the cul-
tivation of bananas, or the planting or
cultivating of the plants, or the harvesting of
bananas;

"Certificate of having passed the dictation test"—
A certificate under the hand of a State officer,
authorised for that purpose by the Secretary
for Agriculture, that, when the said officer has
dictated to the person concerned not less than
fifty words in such language as the Secretary
for Agriculture may direct, such person has
correctly written them out in that language in
the presence of the said officer;

If either House of Parliament, within the next forty sitting days after any regulations have been so laid before such House, resolves that such regulations or any of them ought to be annulled, the same shall after the date of such resolution be of no effect, without prejudice to the validity of anything done in the meantime under such regulations or to the making of any new regulations.

Offences,
how tried.

6. All proceedings for offences against this Act may be had, taken, and determined in a summary manner under **"The Justices Acts, 1886 to 1909"* :

Provided that no proceedings for any offence against this Act shall be instituted except by the direction of the Attorney-General.

Appropriation.

7. The expenses of carrying this Act into effect shall be defrayed out of moneys to be from time to time appropriated by Parliament for the purpose.

An Act to Approve, Confirm, and Ratify an Agreement dated 5th April, 1921, between the Commonwealth of Australia, the State of Queensland, and certain Banks respecting Advances of Money required to Pay for Wheat delivered to the State Wheat Board, and for other consequential purposes.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Wheat Advances Agreement Ratification Act of 1921.*"

2. (1.) The Agreement dated the fifth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, between the Commonwealth of Australia, the State of Queensland, and certain Banking Corporations, a copy whereof is set forth in the Schedule to this Act, is hereby approved, confirmed, and ratified.
