## An Act to Amend the Law relating to the Holding of Offices in Case of the Demise of the Crown.

1 Geo. V. No. 21. THE DEMISE OF THE CROWN ACT OF 1910.

ASSENTED TO 4TH JANUARY, 1911.

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Demise of the Short title. Crown Act of 1910."
- 2. (1.) The holding of any office under the Crown Effect of shall not be affected, nor shall any fresh appointment demise of the Crown on thereto be rendered necessary, by the demise of the Crown. holding of
- (2.) It shall not be necessary for the holder of any office. Office under the Crown who before such demise has taken No. 57 of any oath prescribed or provided for in any Statute to again 1901, s. 2. take such oath after such demise; but where any such oath relates only to the then reigning Sovereign, it shall be deemed to relate to such Sovereign, his Heirs and Successors, according to law.
- (3.) This Act shall take effect as from the last demise of the Crown.
