THE FRUIT CASES ACTS AMENDMENT ACT OF 1922.

E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Fruit Cases Acts short title Amendment Act of 1922," and shall be read as one with and construction *"The Fruit Cases Acts, 1912 to 1916," herein collectively of Act. referred to as the Principal Act.
- 2. After subsection two of section 6A of the Amendment Principal Act, the following subsection is inserted:—
 - [2A.] No person shall—
 - (a) Pack any fruit or vegetables intended for sale unless such fruit or vegetables is or are graded as prescribed by Regulation; or
 - (b) Sell any fruit or vegetables in a package if such fruit or vegetables is not or are not graded as prescribed by Regulation; or

- (c) Sell the whole or any part of any lot of fruit or vegetables unless such lot of fruit or vegetables is stacked as prescribed by Regulation;
- (d) Sell any lot of fruit or vegetables if such fruit or vegetables is not or are not graded as prescribed by Regulation.

No. 27. THE AUC-TIONEERS AND COMMISSION AGENTS ACT of 1922.

13 Geo. v. An Act to provide for the Licensing of Auctioneers and Commission Agents and for purposes incidental thereto.

[Assented to 18th October, 1922.]

E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as "The Auctioneers and Commission Agents Act of 1922."

Operation of Act as to auctioneers.

2. (1.) All the provisions of this Act relating to auctioneers shall come into operation on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-three, and, save as next hereinafter mentioned, shall be in force throughout Queensland.

Exemptions from provisions as to auctioneers.

The provisions of this Act relating to auctioneers shall not apply to—

> (a) Any person selling by auction any Crown lands or other Crown property under the authority of the Secretary for Public Lands or any other competent authority;
