An Act to Amend "The Legal Practitioners Acts, 1881 to 1938," in certain particulars.

[ASSENTED TO 11TH APRIL, 1946.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title
and
construction.

1. (1.) This Act may be cited as "*The Legal Practitioners Acts Amendment Act of 1946*," and shall be read as one with *"*The Legal Practitioners Acts, 1881 to 1938*," herein referred to as the Principal Act.

Collective

(2.) The Principal Act and this Act may collectively be cited as "*The Legal Practitioners Acts, 1881 to 1946*."

2. Section five of †"*The Legal Practitioners Act Amendment Act of 1938*" is amended by adding the following provision thereto, namely:—

"This section does not apply and never did apply to a barrister or solicitor in any Commonwealth or State Department acting in the course of his official duties.

Any such barrister or solicitor so acting shall have the same rights and privileges as if section one of ‡"*The Legal Practitioners Act of 1881*" had not been repealed."
