An Act to Amend "The Police Acts, 1937 to 1955," in a certain particular.

[ASSENTED TO 11TH NOVEMBER, 1957.]

B it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. (1.) This Act may be cited as "The Police Acts Amendment Act of 1957."

Principal Act. (2.) *" The Police Acts, 1937 to 1955," are in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Collective title.

(3.) The Principal Act and this Act may be collectively cited as "The Police Acts, 1937 to 1957."

Amendment of s. 12 (2).

- 2. Subsection two of section twelve of the Principal Act is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:—
- "This subsection does not apply to any employment in which a member of the Police Force, suspended from duty without pay by the Commissioner, engages (whether on his own behalf or as a servant or agent) with the prior approval in writing of the Commissioner, during that suspension."
