**An Act to Amend "The Stamp Act, 1894," so far
as relates to Duties Payable upon Receipts.**

[ASSENTED TO 30TH SEPTEMBER, 1903.]

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN,—

Preamble.

WE Your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal subjects the members of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, towards raising the necessary supplies to defray Your Majesty's public expenses, and making an addition to the public revenue, have freely and voluntarily resolved to give and grant unto Your Majesty the several duties hereinafter mentioned; and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title,
construction,

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Stamp Act Amendment Act of 1903*," and shall be read and construed with and as an amendment of "*The Stamp Act, 1894*,"* hereinafter called the Principal Act. This Act shall commence and take effect on and from the first day of October, one thousand nine hundred and three.

2. (1.) "*The Stamp Act Amendment Act of 1901*"† is hereby repealed.

Duties on
receipts.

(2.) In lieu of subsection three of section seventy-one of the Principal Act repealed by the said last-mentioned Act, the following subsection is inserted:—

"Upon a payment to an amount the receipt for which is liable to duty, gives a receipt for a less amount, or separates or divides the amount paid with intent to evade the whole or any part of the duty."

(3.) In the Schedule to the Principal Act, under the heading "RECEIPT," in lieu of the words

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act shall be read and construed with and as an amendment of "*The Supreme Court Acts, 1867 to 1899*,"* and may be cited together with those Acts as "*The Supreme Court Acts, 1867 to 1903*," and separately as "*The Supreme Court Acts Amendment Act of 1903*." Short title ' and construction of Act.

2. The Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, may appoint the Senior Puisne Judge of the Supreme Court for the time being resident in Brisbane to be the Senior Puisne Judge of the Court. Appointment of Senior Puisne Judge.
