**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1.) This Act may be cited as "*The Sugar Experiment Stations Acts Amendment Act of 1946*," and shall be read as one with \*"*The Sugar Experiment Stations Acts, 1900 to 1941*," herein referred to as the Principal Act. Short title and construction.

(2.) The Principal Act and this Act may collectively be cited as "*The Sugar Experiment Stations Acts, 1900 to 1946*." Collective title.

*Amendments of the Principal Act.*

2. (1.) A new subsection, 1A, is inserted after subsection one of section thirty-one of the Principal Act as follows:— Amendment of s. 31.

"(1A.) Without in any wise limiting the generality of the provisions of subsection one of this section, a Cane Pest and Disease Control Board shall have power and authority to make from its funds such payments as the Minister shall from time to time, upon the recommendation of the Advisory Board, determine and sanction by way of subsidies in respect of the costs incurred by any person for approved baits, fumigants, fungicides, poisons, materials, equipment, machinery, services and/or operations for the destruction and prevention within its area of cane pests and/or diseases. New subsec. 1A. [Power of Board to pay subsidies.]

Moreover when determining and sanctioning any such subsidy the Minister may, upon the further recommendation of the Advisory Board, apportion the amount thereof between the things, services and/or operations in respect of the costs of which such subsidy is to be payable, and the Cane Pest and Disease Control Board concerned shall be bound by such apportionment.

In this subsection the term "approved" means approved by the Minister upon the recommendation of the Advisory Board.

(2.) In subsection four of the said section after the word "fumigants" the words "fungicides, poisons, materials, equipment, machinery" are inserted; also after the words "matters or things" the words "or subsidies" are inserted.

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as "*The War Service (Sugar Industry) Land Settlement Act of 1946.*"

Construction  
of Act.

2. This Act shall be read and construed with the following Acts, that is to say:—

- (i.) \*"*The Regulation of Sugar Cane Prices Acts, 1915 to 1941*" ; and
- (ii.) †"*The Land Acts, 1910 to 1946*" ; and
- (iii.) ‡"*The War Service Land Settlement Act of 1946*" :

Provided that if any provision of such Acts or of any of them shall be inconsistent with any provision of this Act, the provision of this Act shall prevail :

Provided further that any term used in this Act to which a meaning is assigned by such Acts or any of them shall, unless the context of this Act otherwise indicates or requires, have the meaning so assigned to it.
