An Act Relating to Certain Statutory Salaries and Allowances.

[Assented to 14th December, 1960.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

PART I.—PRELIMINARY.

Short title.

1. (1.) This Act may be cited as "The Statutory Salaries and Allowances Act of 1960."

Commencement. (2.) This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on and from the fourth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixty, and shall operate retrospectively accordingly.

- 3. (1.) This Part II. of this Act shall be read as Interpretation of with "The Land Acts, 1910 to 1959."
- (2.) "The Land Acts, 1910 to 1959," and this Collective Part II. of this Act may be collectively cited as "The title. Land Acts, 1910 to 1960."
- 4. Section twenty-one of "The Land Acts, 1910 Amendments of 1 Geo. V. No. 15.
- (i.) By repealing in subsection one the words "four thousand two hundred and fifty pounds per annum" and by inserting, in lieu of those repealed words, the words "five thousand pounds per annum"; and
- (ii.) By repealing in subsection two the words "three thousand seven hundred and fifty pounds per annum" and by inserting, in lieu of those repealed words, the words "four thousand five hundred pounds per annum".

PART III.—AMENDMENTS OF "THE AUDIT ACTS, 1874 TO 1958."

- 5. (1.) This Part III. of this Act shall be read as Interpretation of with "The Audit Acts, 1874 to 1958." Interpretation of Part III.
- (2.) "The Audit Acts, 1874 to 1958," and this Collective Part III. of this Act may be collectively cited as "The Audit Acts, 1874 to 1960."

Amendments of 17 Geo. V. of 1926," is amended—

- (i.) By repealing in subsection one the words "four thousand six hundred and twelve pounds per annum" and by inserting, in lieu of those repealed words, the words "five thousand four hundred pounds per annum"; and
- (ii.) By repealing in subsection two the words "one thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight" and by inserting, in lieu of those repealed words, the words "one thousand nine hundred and sixty".
