HAWKERS REGULATION 1994

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 24 April 2002]

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Hawkers Regulation 1994*.

3 Forms

(1) If a provision of the Act requires or permits a prescribed form to be used for a purpose—

- (a) the chief executive is to approve a form for the purpose; and
- (b) the form approved by the chief executive is the prescribed form for the purpose.

(2) A person may ask the chief executive for a document setting out the approved form for a purpose.

(3) The chief executive must promptly comply with the request.

4 Fees

The fees payable under the Act are set out in the schedule.

5 Licence must be signed

Immediately after a person receives a licence issued to him or her, the person must sign the licence, in ink, in the space provided.

Maximum penalty—8 penalty units.

6 Register of licences

(1) The chief executive must keep a register containing the current details of each licence issued.

(2) A person may inspect the register on payment of the relevant fee set out in the schedule.

7 Display of licensee's name etc. on a vehicle

For the purpose of section 29 of the Act, the letters used to display a licensee's name, the words 'licensed hawker' and the licence number on a vehicle must be at least 50 mm high and written legibly.
