#### Spelling

#### 1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition (Queensland) Temporary Exemptions Regulation* 2009.

#### 2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 September 2009.

#### 3 Temporary exemption about air conditioners—Act, s 8

For the Commonwealth Act, section 46, the *Electricity Regulation 2006*, section 166A is declared to be a law that is exempt from the operation of the Commonwealth Act.

#### 4 Expiry

This regulation expires on 31 August 2010.
