1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition (Queensland) Temporary Exemptions Regulation 2009*.

2 Commencement

This regulation commences on 1 September 2009.

3 Temporary exemption about air conditioners—Act, s 8

For the Commonwealth Act, section 46, the *Electricity Regulation 2006*, section 166A is declared to be a law that is exempt from the operation of the Commonwealth Act.
