Wild Rivers Regulation 2007

[as amended by all amendments that commenced on or before 1 July 2014]

1 Short title

This regulation may be cited as the *Wild Rivers Regulation 2007*.

2 Fee for application for approval of proposed plan

For section 31C(1)(c) of the Act, the prescribed fee for an application for approval of a proposed plan is \$353.30.

3 Specified works—other infrastructure (Act, s 48)

(1) For section 48(2)(c)(ix) of the Act, a jetty, boat ramp or pontoon on, or providing access to, indigenous land is prescribed infrastructure.

(2) In this section—

indigenous land means land held under a following Act by, or on behalf of or for the benefit of, Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander inhabitants or for Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander purposes—

- (a) the *Aurukun and Mornington Shire Leases Act 1978*;
- (b) the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991*;
- (c) the *Torres Strait Islander Land Act 1991*;
- (d) the *Land Act 1994*.
