

## ELIZABETHAE II REGINAE

A.D. 1971

## No. 20 of 1971

An Act for the further appropriation of the revenue of the State for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1971, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 15th April, 1971]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Appropriation Act (No. 1), 1971".

Further issue.

2. Out of the moneys paid to the State by the Commonwealth and any other General Revenue of the State, not otherwise by law specially appropriated, there may be further issued, in addition to all sums by any other Act authorized to be issued and applied for defraying the charges of the Government of the State for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1971, any further sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate two million eight hundred thousand dollars.

3. All moneys issued under this Act, not exceeding the aggregate Appropriation of General amount referred to in section 2 of this Act, shall be applied and Revenue. appropriated for the following purposes:-

4. The issue and payment by the Treasurer, from time to time, of Treasurer to any sums of money for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, not of Governor exceeding in the aggregate the amount specified in section 2 of this by receipt of party. Act, in such portions as the Governor directs by any orders in writing signed by him and countersigned by the Chief Secretary, is hereby authorized; and the Treasurer shall, in his accounts, be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such orders accordingly; and the receipts of the persons to whom such sums are so paid shall be to him a full discharge for the sums for which the receipts are given, and the amounts thereof shall be passed to his credit in account accordingly.

5. If the moneys paid to the State by the Commonwealth and the Power to issue General Revenue of the State are insufficient to make the payments than Revenue authorized by section 3 of this Act, moneys may be issued to make received from the Commongood the deficiency out of loan funds or other public funds or out wealth. of moneys raised by way of bank overdraft.

6. The Treasurer may out of the money appropriated by this Act Power to make make any payment for which money has been included in the supplementary estimates of expenditure of the Government of South Australia, passed by the House of Assembly for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1971 notwithstanding that the payment is in respect of a period prior to the first day of July, 1970.

7. Any amount appropriated by this Act may be paid for the purpose for which it is so appropriated, in addition to any other amount appropriated by law for that purpose.
