An Act for the further appropriation of moneys from Consolidated Account for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1984, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 17 May 1984]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the "Appropriation Act (No. 1), 1984". Short title.
2. (1) The Treasurer may, on or before the thirtieth day of June, 1984, in accordance with this Act and with an order signed by the Governor and countersigned by a Minister of the Crown, issue and pay moneys (not exceeding fourteen million dollars) from Consolidated Account for the purposes mentioned in the schedule. Issue and payment of money by Treasurer.
 - (2) So much of the sum of fourteen million dollars as will be required for the purposes of subsection (1) is appropriated from Consolidated Account.
 - (3) A payment may be made pursuant to subsection (1) in respect of a period prior to the first day of July, 1983.
3. Moneys appropriated by this Act may be issued and paid for a purpose for which they have been appropriated in addition to any other moneys appropriated by law for that purpose. Payments to be in addition to other payments.
