ORDINANCE enacted by the Governor of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

For the Further Appropriation of the Revenue for the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-seven, and for the General Appropriation of the Revenue for the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-eight.

[4th September, 1847.]

WHEREAS by the Laws relative to the Customs and Trade, and Preamble other Acts or Ordinances of this Province, certain Duties, Fines, and other Moneys, are or may be imposed, levied, and collected, to be paid to the Colonial Treasurer, on behalf of HER MAJESTY, Her Heirs, and Successors, for the public uses of the Province, and support of the Government thereof:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED, by THE GOVERNOR of South Australia, with the advice and consent of THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL thereof—That out of the said Duties, and the produce of all or Appropriation of Geany other the Public Revenue of the Province, not otherwise by Law specially provided for, which from time to time hath accrued, or may accrue, or become payable during the year ending on the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-eight, or which shall have been otherwise unappropriated or unprovided for by Law at the commencement of the Year, or which shall from time to time accrue or become payable during the Year ending on the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-nine,

Forty-nine, or which shall be otherwise unappropriated or unprovided for by Law at the commencement of that Year, there shall or may be further issued and applied (over and above all other Sums heretofore appropriated for the like Services) in the manner hereinafter provided, for the several purposes hereinafter mentioned, any Sums of Money not exceeding in amount respectively the several Sums of Money hereinafter specified; that is to say,

II. And with respect to the several Sums voted in aid of Application of the Voluntary Assessments or Contributions for Roads, Bridges, and sums appropriated other Public Improvements; to wit, One Thousand Pounds ap- Contributions Roads. propriated to the said purposes generally for the Year ending the Thirty-first day March, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-Eight, and the Sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Pounds appropropriated towards the making of a Road to the North Arm for the Year ending the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-nine: BE IT ENACTED, that the said several Sums shall and may be issued and applied in manner following; that is to say, whenever a Sum shall have been raised by private contribution, to be applied towards the formation, maintenance, or repair of such Road, Bridge, or necessary Work, on public property, the same being in all respects approved by the Governor, as of public advantage or convenience, it shall be lawful for the Governor (subject to such regulations as shall from time to time be made by the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council), to authorize to be issued from time to time, in aid of the undertaking, any Sums of Money not exceeding in the whole the amount of such private contribution, and not exceeding the respective Sums hereinbefore appropriated for such several undertakings: PROVIDED, that Proviso. no Sum shall be so issued, unless a Sum of equal amount shall have been first paid up and expended out of such private contributions.

III. And BE IT ENACTED, that the Colonial Treasurer shall issue Colonial Treasurer to and pay from time to time, any Sum or Sums of Money for the pur- the Governor, and poses hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding in the whole the Sums discharged by rerespectively in that behalf hereinbefore specified, to such persons ccipt of party.

and in such portions as the Governor for the time being shall, by any order or orders in writing, signed by him, from time to time direct; and the said Treasurer shall, in his accounts, be allowed credit for all Sums paid by him in pursuance of such orders accordingly, and the Receipts of the persons to whom such Sums shall have been so paid, shall be to him a full discharge for the Sum or Sums for which the same Receipts shall have been respectively given, and the amounts thereof shall be passed to his credit in account accordingly.
