An Act for the general appropriation of the revenue of the State for the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1969, and for other purposes.

[Assented to 24th October, 1968.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Appropriation Act (No. 2), 1968".

Further issue.

2. Out of the moneys paid to the State by the Commonwealth of Australia, and any other General Revenue of the said State, not otherwise by law specially appropriated, there may be further issued the sum of one hundred and fifty million, nine hundred and sixty-two thousand, three hundred and fifty-five dollars.

Appropriation of General Revenue.

3. (1) Out of the sum of seventy million dollars issued under the authority of the Supply Act (No. 1), 1968, and the Supply Act (No. 2), 1968, and the said sum of one hundred and fifty million, nine hundred and sixty-two thousand, three hundred and fifty-five dollars by this Act authorized to be issued, there may be applied and paid for defraying the charges of the State Government for the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1969 the sum of two hundred and twenty million, nine hundred and sixty-two thousand, three hundred and fifty-five dollars, the said amount being appropriated as follows, viz.:—

(2) If—

(a) during the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1969 any increases of salaries or wages become payable by the State Government pursuant to any return made under the Acts relating to the public service, or pursuant to any regulation or any award, order or determination of a court or other body empowered to fix salaries or wages;

and

(b) such increases were not provided for in the estimates of expenditure for the said financial year,

the Governor may, by warrant under section 32a of the Public Finance Act, 1936-1964, appropriate out of the General Revenue of the State any money required to pay the said increases.

The aggregate amount of money which may be appropriated under the said section 32a for the said financial year shall be increased by the amount of money appropriated pursuant to this subsection.

(3) The Governor may, by warrant under section 32a of the Public Finance Act, 1936-1964, appropriate out of the General Revenue of the State any money required to meet further expenditure beyond the amounts provided in the estimates of expenditure for the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1969 for costs of electricity supplied to the Engineering and

Water Supply Department for pumping water through the Mannum-Adelaide pipeline and from bores in the Adelaide Water District, and through the Morgan-Whyalla pipeline.

The aggregate amount of money which may be appropriated under the said section 32a for the said financial year shall be increased by the amount of money appropriated pursuant to this subsection.

4. The issue and payment by the Treasurer, from time to time, of any sums of money for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding in the whole the amount hereinbefore by receipt of party.

Color of the Covernor directs by any specified, in such portions as the Governor directs by any orders in writing signed by him and countersigned by the Chief Secretary, is hereby authorized; and the Treasurer shall, in his accounts, be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such orders accordingly; and the receipts of the persons to whom such sums are so paid shall be to him a full discharge for the sums for which the receipts are given, and the amounts thereof shall be passed to his credit in account accordingly.

5. If the moneys paid to the State by the Commonwealth of Australia and the General Revenue of the State are insufficient to make the payments authorized by section 3 of this Act, received from the Commonwealth of the Commonwe moneys may be issued to make good the deficiency out of wealth. loan funds or other public funds or out of moneys raised by way of bank overdraft.

6. The Treasurer may—

Power to make payments.

(a) out of the moneys appropriated by this Act and included in the estimates of expenditure of the Government of South Australia, passed by the House of Assembly for the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1969:

(b) out of any money which may be appropriated pursuant to subsection (2) of section 3 of this Act,

make any payment notwithstanding that the payment is in respect of a period prior to the first day of July, 1968.

7. The Treasurer may out of the account in the Treasury Expenditure from Hospitals known as the "Hospital's Fund" expend such sums as may, in Fund. accordance with any Act, be available therein for the purposes of the provision, maintenance, development and improvement of public hospitals and equipment for public hospitals: Provided that such expenditure shall not exceed in the aggregate—

- (a) during the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1969, the sum of two million seven hundred and sixty-five thousand dollars;
- (b) during the period between the thirtieth day of June, 1969, and the commencement of the Act for the general appropriation of the revenue of the State for the year ending on the thirtieth day of June, 1970, the sum of one million dollars.

Payments to be in addition to other payments.

8. Any amount appropriated by this Act may be paid for the purpose for which it is so appropriated, in addition to any other amount appropriated by law for that purpose.
