*ORDINANCE enacted by the Governor of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.*

*For the Further Appropriation of the Revenue for the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-eight, and for the General Appropriation of the Revenue for the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-nine.*

[20th June, 1848.]

**W**HEREAS by the Laws relative to the Customs and Trade, Preamble. and other Acts or Ordinances of this Province, certain Duties, Fines, and other Moneys, are or may be imposed, levied, and collected, to be paid to the Colonial Treasurer, on behalf of HER MAJESTY, Her Heirs, and Successors, for the public uses of the Province, and support of the Government thereof:

**BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED**, by THE GOVERNOR of South Australia, Appropriation of General Revenue. with the advice and consent of THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL thereof—  
**THAT** out of the said Duties, and the produce of all or any other the Public Revenue of the Province, not otherwise by Law specially provided for, which from time to time hath accrued, or may accrue, or become payable during the year ending on the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-nine, or which shall have

have been otherwise unappropriated or unprovided for by Law at the commencement of the Year, or which shall from time to time accrue or become payable during the Year ending on the Thirty-first day of March, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty, or which shall be otherwise unappropriated or unprovided for by Law at the commencement of that Year, there shall or may be further issued and applied (over and above all other Sums heretofore appropriated for the like Services) in the manner hereinafter provided, for the several purposes hereinafter mentioned, any Sums of Money not exceeding in amount respectively the several Sums of Money hereinafter specified; that is to say,

I. FOR THE SERVICES

II. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the Colonial Treasurer shall issue and pay, from time to time, any Sum or Sums of Money for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, not exceeding, in the whole, the Sums respectively in that behalf hereinbefore specified, to such persons, and in such portions as the Governor for the time being shall, by any order or orders, in writing, signed by him, from time to time direct; and the said Treasurer shall, in his Accounts, be allowed credit for all sums paid by him in pursuance of such orders accordingly; and the Receipts of the persons to whom such Sums shall have been so paid, shall be to him a full discharge for the Sum or Sums for which the same Receipts shall have been respectively given, and the amounts thereof shall be passed to his credit in account accordingly.

Colonial Treasurer to pay on the orders of the Governor, and discharged by receipt of party.
