An Act to reduce the Fees payable under the "Aliens Act, 1864."

[Assented to, 12th March, 1872.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to reduce the fees payable under the "Aliens Act, 1864"—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Preamble.

1. Schedule B of the "Aliens Act, 1864," is hereby repealed, and the following substituted in lieu thereof, viz.:—
