An Act to amend the Laws relating to Aliens.

[Reserved, March 20, 1856.]

THEREAS it is expedient to amend the laws relating to Aliens within this Province—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor in-Chief of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Preamble.

1. Every Alien who shall have received such certificate and taken Aliens having received such oath as are authorized and prescribed by an Ordinance, No. 7 oath may, after five of 1846, "To amend the Laws relating to Aliens," and who shall years' residence, become Members of have resided five years within the said Province, shall be capable Council or Legislature. of becoming a Member of Her Majesty's Council, and of the Legislature, in like manner as a natural born subject of Her Majesty, unless such capacities or either of them shall be expressly excepted out of any such certificate to be hereafter granted.

2. All hereditaments which have been or shall be acquired by, and which have been or shall be transmitted to, or disposed of by by Aliens not liable to or through any person not being a natural born subject of Her Majesty, or naturalized according to law, shall, notwithstanding, be deemed and taken to have been lawfully acquired, transmitted, and disposed of, and not to have been escheated or forfeited, or to be liable to escheat or forfeiture.
