An Act to amend the Agent-General Act, 1901-1949.

[Assented to 22nd October, 1953.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Agent-General Act Amendment Act, 1953". Short titles.
- (2) The Agent-General Act, 1901-1949 as amended by this Act may be cited as the "Agent-General Act, 1901-1953".
- (3) The Agent-General Act, 1901-1949 is hereinafter called "the principal Act".
2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation.
3. Section 5 of the principal Act is repealed and the following section enacted in its place :— Repeal of s. 5 of principal Act and enactment of other provisions—
Salary and allowances of Agent-General.
 5. (1) There shall be paid to the Agent-General—
 - (a) a salary at the rate of two thousand pounds sterling a year ;
 - (b) an expenses allowance at the rate of one thousand pounds sterling a year.
 - (2) The salary and allowance of the Agent-General shall be paid by twelve monthly instalments in each year.

(3) The rates of salary and allowance prescribed by this section shall be deemed to have come into operation on the sixth day of August nineteen hundred and fifty-three, and the Agent-General shall be entitled to payment in one sum of any arrears of salary and allowance to which he is entitled by virtue of this subsection.

(4) This section without further appropriation shall be sufficient authority for the payment out of the general revenue of the State of salary, allowance and arrears as mentioned in this section.
