An Act to amend the Auctioneers' Act, 1862.

[Assented to, October 6th, 1920.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Auctioneers' Act Amendment Act, 1920." Short titles.

(2) The Auctioneers' Act, 1862 (hereinafter called "the principal Act"), and this Act may be cited together as the "Auctioneers' Acts, 1862 to 1920." No. 9 of 1862.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act, and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation with principal Act.

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by substituting for the word "Full" in the fifth line thereof the word "Limited", and

(b) by substituting for the word "Magistrates" in the seventh line thereof the words "Special Magistrate or Justices."

Amendment of principal Act, s. 4—
Local Court to issue licence.
