GEORGII V REGIS.

An Act to amend the Auctioneers' Act, 1862.

[Assented to, October 6th, 1920.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Auctioneers' Act short titles. Amendment Act, 1920."
- (2) The Auctioneers' Act, 1862 (hereinafter called "the principal No. 9 of 1862. Act"), and this Act may be cited together as the "Auctioneers' Acts, 1862 to 1920."
- 2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act, and that Act Incorporation with and this Act shall be read as one Act.
 - 3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended—

Amendment of principal Act, s. 4—

f Local Court to issue

- (a) by substituting for the word "Full" in the fifth line thereof Local Court to issue the word "Limited", and
- (b) by substituting for the word "Magistrates" in the seventh line thereof the words "Special Magistrate or Justices."
