## No. 54 of 1949.

An Act to amend the Agent-General Act, 1901-1948.

[Assented to 8th December, 1949.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the " Agent-General Act Amendment Act, 1949 ".

(2) The Agent-General Act, 1901-1948, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the " Agent-General Act, 1901-1949 ".

(3) The Agent-General Act, 1901-1948, is hereinafter called " the principal Act ".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Term of office.

3. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word " forty-nine " at the end of subsection (2) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the word " fifty-two ".
