An Act to amend the Agent-General Act, 1901-1948.

[Assented to 8th December, 1949.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Agent-General Act Amendment Act, 1949".
- (2) The Agent-General Act, 1901-1948, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Agent-General Act, 1901-1949".
- (3) The Agent-General Act, 1901-1948, is hereinafter called "the principal Act".

Incorporation.

2. This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.

Amendment of s. 6 of principal Act— Term of office. 3. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the word "forty-nine" at the end of subsection (2) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof the word "fifty-two".
