An Act to amend the Audit Act, 1921-1949.

[Assented to 6th September, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

- Short titles.** **1.** (1) This Act may be cited as the " Audit Act Amendment Act, 1951 ".
- (2) The Audit Act, 1921-1949, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the " Audit Act, 1921-1951 ".
- (3) The Audit Act, 1921-1949, is hereinafter referred to as " the principal Act ".
- Incorporation.** **2.** This Act is incorporated with the principal Act and that Act and this Act shall be read as one Act.
- Amendment of principal Act, s. 6—
Salary of Auditor-General.** **3.** Section 6 of the principal Act is amended—
- (a) by striking out at the end of subsection (1) the words " such rate as the Governor fixes " and inserting in their place the words " rate of two thousand three hundred pounds a year " ;
- (b) by striking out subsection (3).
- Commencement of Act.** **4.** This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and fifty-one.
