## GEORGII V REGIS. A.D. 1926.

## No. 1735.

An Act to Authorise the Construction of a Bridge across Spencer's Gulf at Port Augusta, and for other purposes.

## [Assented to, September 30th, 1926.]

E it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia. with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the "Port Augusta Bridge Act, Short title. 1926."
- 2. (1) The Minister of Local Government is hereby authorised Power to construct and empowered to construct, or cause to be constructed, a bridge bridge across Spencer's Gulf at over and across Spencer's Gulf at Port Augusta, and may form and Port Augusta. make, or cause to be formed and made, all necessary embankments, approaches, roads, piers, buildings, and other works necessary for the completion of the said bridge.

- (2) The said bridge and the approaches thereto shall be constructed at or near the site shown in the plan in the Schedule hereto and therein hachured black.
- (3) The said bridge shall be constructed out of moneys provided by Parliament for the purpose.
- 3. (1) The portion of the said bridge and the approaches thereto Maintenance of between the boundary of the Municipality of Port Augusta and low bridge. water mark on the western side of Spencer's Gulf (which said boundary and low water mark are delineated in the plan in the Schedule hereto) and any road or street constructed over or upon

the said portion of the said bridge and approaches shall be maintained by the Corporation of the Town of Port Augusta at all times.

(2) The portion of the said bridge and the approaches thereto between the boundary of the Municipality of Port Augusta West and the low water mark mentioned in subsection (1) hereof (which said boundary is delineated in the plan in the Schedule hereto) and any road or street constructed over or upon the said portion of the said bridge and approaches shall be maintained by the Corporation of the Town of Port Augusta West at all times.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
