An Act to amend the Alsatian Dogs Act, 1934.

[Assented to 8th December, 1949.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the " Alsatian Dogs Act Amendment Act, 1949 " Short titles.

(2) The Alsatian Dogs Act, 1934, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the " Alsatian Dogs Act, 1934-1949 ".

(3) The Alsatian Dogs Act, 1934, is hereinafter referred to as " the principal Act ".

2. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the word " and " in the last line of paragraph (b) of subsection (4), thereof ;

(b) by inserting after the word " apply " in the last line of paragraph (c) of subsection (4) thereof the word " ; and " ;

(c) by adding at the end of subsection (4) thereof the following paragraph :—

(d) within any part of Kangaroo Island to which the Governor by regulation declares that this Act shall apply.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 3—
Prohibition of keeping Alsatian dogs in certain parts of the State.
