An Act to suspend further the levy and collection of amusements duty under the Stamp Duties Act, 1923-1960.

*[Assented to 10th October, 1963.]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short title.

**1.** This Act may be cited as the "Amusements Duty (Further Suspension) Act, 1963".

Interpretation.

**2.** In this Act "amusements duty", "amusement", and "admission" have the meanings assigned to them in Part IV of the Stamp Duties Act, 1923-1960.

Suspension of amusements duty.

**3.** No amusements duty shall be charged, levied, or paid on any payment for admission to any amusement held before the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-seven.
