An Act to amend the Adelaide Festival Centre Trust Act, 1971.

[Assented to 6th April, 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Adelaide Festival Centre Trust Act Amendment Act, 1972".
- (2) The Adelaide Festival Centre Trust Act, 1971, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Adelaide Festival Centre Trust Act, 1971-1972".
- (3) The Adelaide Festival Centre Trust Act, 1971, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 24—

2. Section 24 of the principal Act is amended by inserting immediately after subsection (1) the following subsection:—

Construction of Drama Facilities.

- (1a) In addition to and without derogating from the powers conferred on the Trust by subsection (1) of this section, the Trust may out of moneys to be provided by Parliament for the purpose or out of moneys borrowed pursuant to section 26 of this Act, construct and provide on, over or under any land, not vested and not to be vested in the Trust, with the consent of the owner of that land—
 - (a) such means of access to land vested in the Trust or which may be vested in the Trust as are, in the opinion of the Trust, necessary or desirable;

- (b) such buildings, works and conveniences, the construction and provision of which, in the opinion of the Trust, is necessary or desirable to secure to the Trust the full and convenient use of land vested in the Trust or which may be vested in the Trust.
- 3. Section 26 of the principal Act is amended by inserting in Amendment of subsection (1) after the passage "The Trust may" the passage "with subsection subsection (2) after the passage "The Trust may" the passage "with subsection subsection subsection (3) after the passage "The Trust may" the passage "with subsection the consent of the Treasurer".
