An Act to amend the Adelaide Festival Centre Trust Act, 1971.

[Assented to 11 April 1985]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Adelaide Festival Centre Trust short title. Act Amendment Act, 1985".
- (2) The Adelaide Festival Centre Trust Act, 1971, is in this Act referred to as "the principal Act".
- 2. This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by procla- Commencement. mation.
 - 3. Section 6 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out subsection (1) and substituting the following sub- Composition of the Trust section:

- (1) The Trust shall consist of eight trustees, of whom—
 - (a) six shall be persons nominated by the Minister;
 - (b) one shall be a person nominated by the Council from amongst the members of the Council or the officers of the Council;

and

- (c) one shall be a person nominated by the Adelaide Festival of Arts Incorporated.;
- (b) by striking out from subsection (3) the passage "the Council notice in writing requiring the council" and substituting the passage "a nominating authority notice in writing requiring it";
- (c) by inserting in subsection (3) after the passage "paragraph (b)" the passage "or paragraph (c)";
- (d) by striking out from subsection (3) the word "Council" last occurring and substituting the word "authority";

and

- (e) by inserting after subsection (5) the following subsection:
 - (6) The Governor may appoint a suitable person to be a deputy of any trustee, and a person so appointed may act as a trustee in the absence of the trustee of whom he has been appointed a deputy.
