An Act to amend the Advances for Homes Acts,
1910 to 1921.

[*Assented to, October 25th, 1922.*]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia,
with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof,
as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited alone as the "Advances for Homes Act Further Amendment Act, 1922." Short titles.

(2) The Advances for Homes Acts, 1910 to 1921, and this Act may be cited together as the "Advances for Homes Acts, 1910 to 1922."

2. This Act is incorporated with the other Acts mentioned in section 1 of this Act, and those Acts and this Act shall be read as one Act. Incorporation with other Acts.

3. (1) Section 8 of the Advances for Homes Act, 1910, is further amended by substituting for the words "Six Hundred Thousand Pounds" in subsection (2) thereof the words "One Million Two Hundred Thousand Pounds." Amendment of Act 1018, 1910, s. 8—
Advances for Homes Fund.

(2) The amendment made by this section shall apply only in respect of the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-three. Cf. Act 1467, 1921, s. 4.
