**An Act to amend the Advances for Homes Act,  
1928-1968.**

*[Assented to 27th August, 1970]*

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia,  
with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Advances for Homes Act Amendment Act, 1970". Short titles.

(2) The Advances for Homes Act, 1928-1968, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Advances for Homes Act, 1928-1970".

(3) The Advances for Homes Act, 1928-1968, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 18 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (4) the passage "eight thousand dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "nine thousand dollars". Amendment of principal Act, s. 18—  
Sale of dwelling houses.

3. Section 22 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (5) the passage "eight thousand dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "nine thousand dollars". Amendment of principal Act, s. 22—  
Advances for homes.

4. Section 35 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (2) the passage "eight thousand dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "nine thousand dollars". Amendment of principal Act, s. 35—  
Power for bank to acquire freehold.

5. Section 40 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from paragraph (b) of subsection (2) the passage "eight thousand dollars" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "nine thousand dollars".
