**An Act to vest part of the Arthur Hardy Sanctuary in the Board of the Botanic Gardens;
and for other related purposes.**

[Assented to 16 March 1989]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Arthur Hardy Sanctuary (Alteration of Boundary) Act, 1989*.

Commencement

2. This Act will come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.

Interpretation

3. In this Act—

“the Board” means the Board of the Botanic Gardens:

“the land” means that area of land, being portion of the land contained in section 459 (the Arthur Hardy Sanctuary), Hundred of Onkaparinga, County of Adelaide, delineated by shading in the plan contained in the schedule.

Land vests in Board

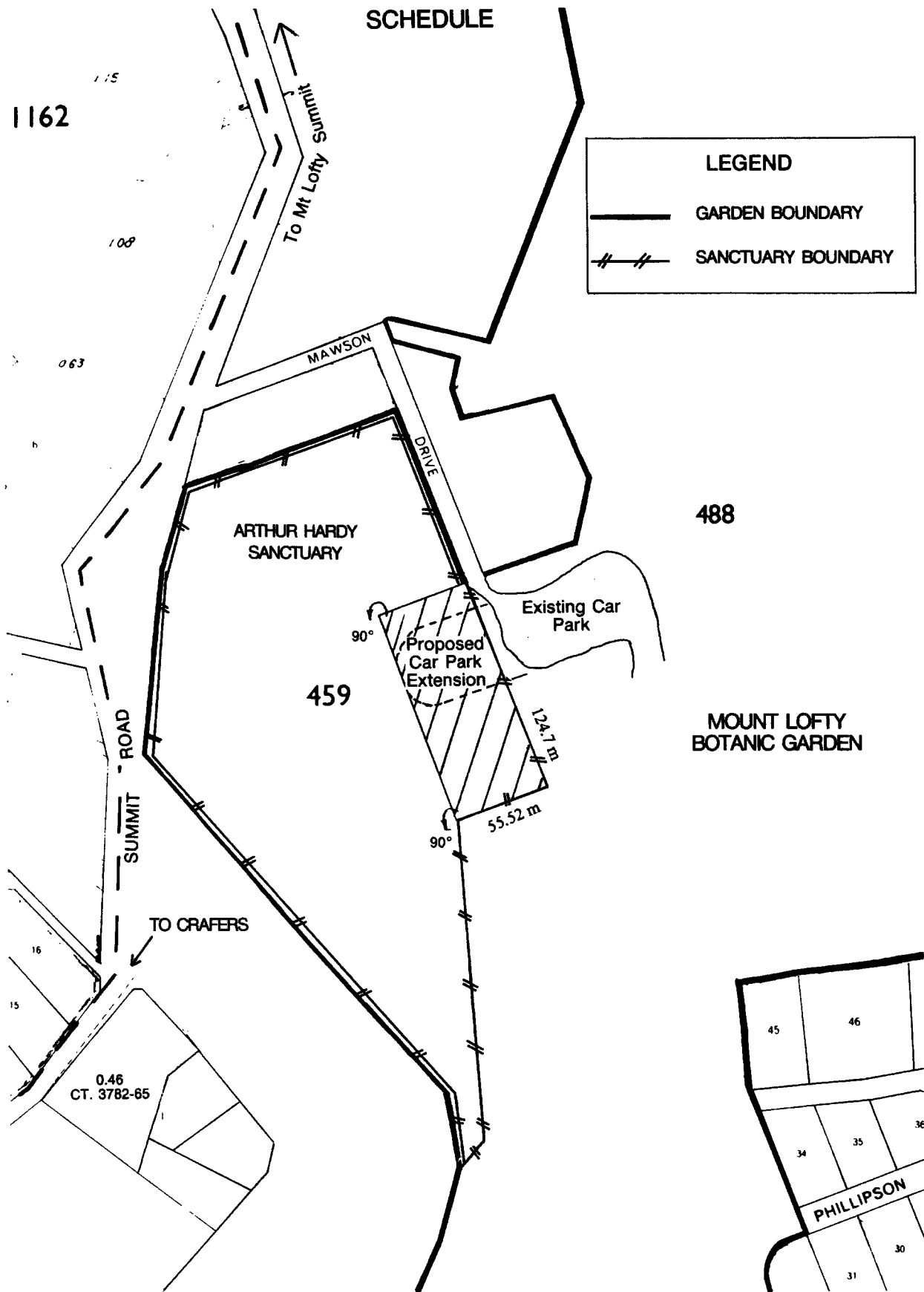
4. (1) The land is vested in the Board for an estate in fee simple and is freed and discharged from—

(a) any trust affecting the land immediately prior to the commencement of this Act;
and

(b) any rights, interests or claims affecting the land immediately prior to the commencement of this Act.

Land to form part of the Mt. Lofty Botanic Garden

5. The Board must use the land for the public benefit as part of the Mt. Lofty Botanic Garden.
