An Act to amend the "Associations Incorporation Act, 1890."

[Assented to, December 11th, 1897.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the "Associations Incorporation Act, 1890"—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Parliament of South Australia, as follows: Preamble.

1. This Act may be cited as the "Associations Incorporation Act, 1890, Amendment Act, 1897." Title.

2. This Act shall be incorporated and read with the "Associations Incorporation Act, 1890." Incorporation.

3. Section 4 of the "Associations Incorporation Act, 1890," is hereby amended by— Amendment.

(a) The omission of the word "written" and the insertion in lieu thereof of the word "public" between the words "give" and "notice" in the first line of sub-section (a):

(b) The insertion of the words "publication of the" between the words "the" and "last" in the second line of sub-section (b).

4. Section 6 of the "Associations Incorporation Act, 1890," is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "the time by which" between the words "during" and "such" in the twenty-ninth line of the said section, and by leaving out "as" at the beginning of Amendment of sec. 6.

5. Every association incorporated under the Associations Incorporation Acts of 1858, 1887, and 1890 is hereby declared to be an association within the meaning of section 109 of “The Companies Act, 1892.”
