### No. 22 of 1957.

#### An Act to amend the Associations Incorporation Act, 1956.

[Assented to 31st October, 1957.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Associations Incorporation Act Amendment Act, 1957". Short titles.

(2) The Associations Incorporation Act, 1956, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Associations Incorporation Act, 1956-1957".

(3) The Associations Incorporation Act, 1956, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. Section 22 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the words "and any transfer in contravention of this subsection shall be void" in subsection (4) thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "but, notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this subsection, nothing in this subsection shall affect the title of any *bona fide* transferee under any transfer of any such property".
