An Act to amend the Acts Interpretation Act 1915.

[Assented to 28 February 1994]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Acts Interpretation (Commencement Proclamations) Amendment Act 1994.
 - (2) The Acts Interpretation Act 1915 is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

Amendment of s. 7—Commencement of Acts

- 2. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended by inserting the following subsection after subsection (4):
 - (4a) The Governor may, by proclamation, vary or revoke a proclamation referred to in subsection (3) that provides for the commencement of the *Children's Protection Act 1993* or of a provision of that Act.

Repeal of section 7 (4a) of the principal Act

3. Subsection (4a) of section 7 of the principal Act is repealed on 31 December 1994.
