AN ACT to amend "An Act to constitute a Municipal Corporation Repeated to for the City of Adelaide."

No. 1.

WHEREAS an Act of the Governor and Council of South Australia was passed in the Fourth year of Her present Majesty's Reign intituled "An Act to constitute a Municipal Corporation for the City of 4thVietoria No.4. Adelaide" And whereas it is expedient that the same should be amended in manner hereinafter provided-

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY HIS EXCELLENCY GEORGE GREY ESQUIRE Governor and Commander-in-Chief of Her Majesty's Province of South Australia and its Dependencies and Vice Admiral of the same by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows that is to say That it shall be lawful for Her Majesty Her Heirs and Successors and for the Governor for the time being of the said Province with the advice and consent

consent of the Legislative Council thereof at any time to abridge to amend and to take away the corporate rights by the said Act created and the said Act and any enactment provision or clause thereof to amend alter and repeal in such manner as to Her said Majesty Her Heirs and Successors or to the Governor with advice and consent aforesaid may appear fit and expedient anything in the said Act contained to the contrary notwithstanding.
