An Act to amend the Advances to Settlers Act, 1930-1958.

[Assented to 3rd October, 1968.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Advances to Settlers Act Amendment Act, 1968".
- (2) The Advances to Settlers Act, 1930-1958, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Advances to Settlers Act, 1930-1968".
- (3) The Advances to Settlers Act, 1930-1958, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Amendment of principal Act, s. 7—

Advances to settlers.

2. Subsection (2) of section 7 of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "two thousand four hundred pounds" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "six thousand dollars".

Amendment of principal Act, 8. 12a—
Special provision for the making of advances for the erection of dwelling-

3. Subsection (2) of section 12a of the principal Act is amended by striking out the passage "three thousand five hundred pounds" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "eight thousand dollars".

General amendment of principal Act relating to decimal currency. 4. The principal Act is amended by striking out each passage therein (except any passage amended by this Act) representing an amount of money in terms of the currency provided for by the Coinage Act 1909-1947 of the Commonwealth and inserting

in lieu thereof in each case a passage representing the equivalent amount of money in terms of the currency provided for by the Currency Act 1965 of the Commonwealth calculated on the basis of the equivalents specified in subsection (4) of section 8 of that Act.
