An Act to amend "The Adelaide University Act," No. 20 of 1874, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, 25th October, 1879.]

WHEREAS, in order to enable the University of Adelaide to Preamble. obtain a grant of Royal Letters Patent, and for other reasons, it is expedient to amend "The Adelaide University Act"—Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly of the said province, in this present Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. The University of Adelaide has been duly constituted and University has been appointed according to the provisions of "The Adelaide University Act."

2. Subject to the proviso contained in the eighth section of the Power to repeal said Act, the Council of the said University may by Statute or ReguRegulations. lation repeal Statutes and Regulations made by the University; and that section shall be read and construed as if the words "or Regulation" had been inserted in it next after "Statute" where that word occurs lastly therein.

3. The words "Bachelor of Science and Doctor of Science," Repeal of power to which occur in the twelfth section of the said Act, are hereby degrees. repealed; and that section shall be read and construed as if those words had not occurred therein.

Short title.

4. This Act may be cited as "The Adelaide University Act Amendment Act."
