An Act to amend the Brands Act, 1933-1966, and to repeal section 7 of the Brands Act Amendment Act, 1955.

[Assented to 18th September, 1969.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Brands Act Amendment Act, 1969". Short titles.

(2) The Brands Act, 1933-1966, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Brands Act, 1933-1969".

(3) The Brands Act, 1933-1966, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

2. The twelfth schedule to the principal Act is amended by striking out from the description of Division No. 2 the passage "thence northward to the 30th degree of longitude" and inserting in lieu thereof the passage "thence northward to the 30th degree of latitude". Amendment of the twelfth schedule to principal Act.

3. Section 7 of the Brands Act Amendment Act, 1955, is repealed. Repeal of s. 7 of Brands Act Amendment Act, 1955.
