An Act to amend the Boating Act, 1974.

[Assented to 23rd October, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Boating Act Amendment Act, 1975".
- (2) The Boating Act, 1974, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Boating Act, 1974-1975".

Commence-
ment.

2. (1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, this Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.
- (2) This Act shall not come into operation until Her Majesty's pleasure thereon has been publicly signified in this State.

Amendment of
principal Act,
s. 11—
Application of
this Part.

3. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—
 - (1) This Part applies to a motor boat whether or not—
 - (a) the motor boat is required to be registered under the provisions of any other Act or law;
 - and
 - (b) whether or not the motor boat is in fact registered under the provisions of any other Act or law,
 but does not apply to a motor boat exempted from the provisions of this Part by proclamation.
