An Act to amend the Boating Act, 1974.

[Assented to 23rd October, 1975]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

Short titles.

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Boating Act Amendment Act, 1975".
- (2) The Boating Act, 1974, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".
- (3) The principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Boating Act, 1974-1975".

Commencement.

- 2. (1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, this Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation.
- (2) This Act shall not come into operation until Her Majesty's pleasure thereon has been publicly signified in this State.

Amendment of principal Act, s. 11—
Application of this Part.

- 3. Section 11 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following subsection:—
 - (1) This Part applies to a motor boat whether or not—
 - (a) the motor boat is required to be registered under the provisions of any other Act or law; and
 - (b) whether or not the motor boat is in fact registered under the provisions of any other Act or law,

but does not apply to a motor boat exempted from the provisions of this Part by proclamation.
