# An Act to amend the Boating Act, 1974.

[Assented to 20 December 1990]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

#### Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Boating Act Amendment Act, 1990.
- (2) The Boating Act, 1974, is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

### **Delegation**

- 2. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph (a) in subsection (2) the following paragraph:
  - (ab) may delegate to a person who carries on a business of selling motor boats—
    - (i) the power to issue permits in respect of boats sold by the person authorizing operation of the boats pending their registration;

and

(ii) the power to assign registration numbers to those boats;.

# Transfer of registration

3. Section 16a of the principal Act is amended by inserting the following penalty provision after subsection (1):

Penalty: Division 9 fine.

# Interpretation

4. Section 30a of the principal Act is amended by striking out "Minister of Transport" from the definition of "alcotest" and substituting "Governor".

# Evidence, etc.

5. Section 30f of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (2) "or 30g".
