An Act to amend the Boating Act, 1974.

[Assented to 20 December 1990]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Boating Act Amendment Act, 1990*.
- (2) The *Boating Act, 1974*, is referred to in this Act as “the principal Act”.

Delegation

2. Section 7 of the principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph (a) in subsection (2) the following paragraph:

(ab) may delegate to a person who carries on a business of selling motor boats—

- (i) the power to issue permits in respect of boats sold by the person authorizing operation of the boats pending their registration;

and

- (ii) the power to assign registration numbers to those boats;

Transfer of registration

3. Section 16a of the principal Act is amended by inserting the following penalty provision after subsection (1):

Penalty: Division 9 fine.

Interpretation

4. Section 30a of the principal Act is amended by striking out “Minister of Transport” from the definition of “alcotest” and substituting “Governor”.

Evidence, etc.

5. Section 30f of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (2) "or 30g".
