An Act to amend the Business Agents Act, 1938-1949.

[Assented to 27th September, 1951.]

BE IT ENACTED by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows :

Short titles.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the "Business Agents Act Amendment Act, 1951".

(2) The Business Agents Act, 1938-1949, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the "Business Agents Act, 1938-1951".

(3) The Business Agents Act, 1938-1949, is hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act".

Fees.

2. Section 18 of the principal Act is amended—

(a) by striking out the words "thirty-first day of December" in the ninth and tenth lines thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "thirtieth day of September";

(b) by striking out the words "thirtieth day of June" in the tenth line thereof and by inserting in lieu thereof the words "thirty-first day of March".
