An Act to authorise the construction of certain Works for the Storage and Distribution of Water, and for other purposes.

[Assented to, December 6th, 1923.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor of the State of South Australia, with the advice and consent of the Parliament thereof, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the "Blackwood and Belair Water-works Act, 1923." Short title.

2. This Act is incorporated with the Waterworks Act, 1882, and all Acts incorporated with that Act, except sections 110, 114, 115, 116, 117, and 118 of the Land Clauses Consolidation Act. Incorporation with other Acts. No. 269 of 1882. No. 6 of 1947.

3. The Commissioner of Waterworks may, out of moneys voted by Parliament for the purpose—

Commissioner of Waterworks may construct Blackwood and Belair Water Scheme.

(a) construct and maintain waterworks to be known as the Blackwood and Belair Waterworks, and all other works which from time to time are found to be necessary or convenient in connection therewith, within the water district to be called the "Blackwood and Belair Water District" shown and margined yellow on the plan deposited on the eleventh day of September, nineteen hundred and twenty-three, in the office of the Surveyor-General, marked "Blackwood and Belair Water District," signed "Charles A. Bayer, Hydraulic Engineer," and dated the thirtieth day of July, nineteen hundred and twenty-three, and within the catchment areas shown and margined red on the said plan; and

(b) construct

Blackwood and Belair Waterworks Act.—1923.

(b) construct and maintain such works and do such things as from time to time are found to be necessary or convenient for conveying and distributing the water stored in the said waterworks to and through the said district.

Districts which may be supplied.

4. The water stored in the said waterworks may be used—

(a) for the supply of the Blackwood and Belair Water District ;
and

(b) for the supply of any other water district.

Blackwood and Belair Water District constituted a water district under the Waterworks Act, 1882.

5. The Blackwood and Belair Water District is hereby constituted and declared to be a water district for the purposes of the Waterworks Act, 1882.

Water rate must be sufficient to pay interest of 4 per cent. on capital cost of waterworks.

6. Any water rate levied within the Blackwood and Belair Water District shall be of such amount as will be sufficient to pay interest at the rate of not less than four per centum per annum on the capital cost of the said waterworks.

Meaning of Blackwood and Belair Water District.

7. In this Act the term " Blackwood and Belair Water District " means the Blackwood and Belair Water District referred to in section 3, with any addition which at any time may be made thereto by proclamation under the Waterworks Act, 1882, or the said Blackwood and Belair Water District as the same for the time being exists in consequence of any alteration of the boundaries thereof so made.

How work is to be carried out.

8. The Commissioner of Waterworks shall call for tenders for the construction of the head works for the waterworks referred to in this Act, to be sent in within such time, to such place, and to be upon and subject to such terms, conditions, and provisions as he deems advisable, and may accept or reject any tender ; and he may construct the said works himself if no tender for the construction thereof is accepted. The Commissioner of Waterworks, if he thinks proper, may, for the purpose of constructing the said works, contract by petty contracts or on piecework rates for the construction of any part thereof.

In the name and on behalf of His Majesty, I hereby assent to this Bill.
