#### An Act to amend the Biological Control Act 1986.

[Assented to 4 April 1996]

The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

#### Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Biological Control (Miscellaneous) Amendment Act 1996.
- (2) The Biological Control Act 1986 is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

#### Amendment of s. 3—Interpretation

- 2. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended—
- (a) by inserting in the definition of "Commonwealth Act" in subsection (1) "as amended from time to time" after "of the Commonwealth";
- (b) by striking out from subsection (1) the definition of "Council" and substituting the following definition:

#### "Council" means—

- (a) the body known as the Agriculture and Resource Management Council of Australia and New Zealand:-or
- (b) if another body is prescribed by the regulations for the purposes of this definition, that other body;

#### Amendment of s. 8-South Australian Biological Control Authority

- 3. Section 8 of the principal Act is amended by striking out subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection:
  - (2) The Authority is the Council member who is the Minister to whom the administration of this Act is for the time being committed.

#### Amendment of s. 9-Delegation

4. Section 9 of the principal Act is amended by striking out from subsection (1) "Department of Agriculture" and substituting "Department of Primary Industries".

#### Amendment of s. 53-Service of documents on Authority

5. Section 53 of the principal Act is amended by striking out "Department of Agriculture" and substituting "Department of Primary Industries".
