#### The Parliament of South Australia enacts as follows:

## Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Barley Marketing (Miscellaneous) Amendment Act 2000.
- (2) The Barley Marketing Act 1993 is referred to in this Act as "the principal Act".

## Amendment of s. 3—Interpretation

- 2. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended—
- (a) by striking out the definitions of "Victorian Act" and "Victorian Minister";
- (b) by striking out subsection (2).

#### Substitution of s. 5

3. Sections 5, 6 and 7 of the principal Act are repealed and the following section is substituted:

## Review of operation of Part 4

- 5. (1) The Minister must, at the end of two years from the commencement of this section, review the operation of Part 4.
- (2) A report on the review must be prepared and laid before both Houses of Parliament.

#### Insertion of new section

4. The following section is inserted in Part 10 of the principal Act before section 74:

#### Annual report

73. ABB Grain Ltd must give to the Minister a copy of its annual report under the Corporations Law together with such information about the operations of ABB Grain Ltd and ABB Grain Export Ltd as the Minister requires.

### Amendment of s. 74—Regulations

- 5. Section 74 of the principal Act is amended—
- (a) by striking out from subsection (1) ", on the recommendation of the Minister after consultation with the Victorian Minister,";
- (b) by striking out from subsection (3)(a) "at the office of the Board" and substituting "at a place approved by the Minister".

### Repeal of s. 83

**6.** Section 83 of the principal Act is repealed.
