An Act to amend the Constitution.

[Reserved, December 21st, 1899.]

BE it Enacted by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Parliament of South Australia, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Constitution Amendment Act, 1899," and shall be incorporated with "The Constitution Act" and its amendments. Short title and incorporation.

2. No Member of either House of the Parliament of the Commonwealth of Australia shall be qualified for nomination or election as a Member of either House of the Parliament of South Australia. Disqualification of Federal members for local Parliament.

3. If any Member of either House of the Parliament of South Australia shall be elected a Member of either House of the Parliament of the Commonwealth of Australia he shall vacate his seat in the Parliament of South Australia on taking his seat in the Parliament of the Commonwealth. Members of local Parliament to vacate seats on sitting in Federal Parliament.
