An Act to amend the Act No. 22 of 1870-71, intituled "An Act to amend the Companies Act, 1864."

[Assented to, 21st August, 1878.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act No. 22 of 1870-71, Preamble.
intituled "An Act to amend the Companies Act, 1864"—
Be it therefore Enacted by the Governor of the Province of South
Australia, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
and House of Assembly of the said Province, in this present Parlia-
ment assembled, in manner following, that is to say:

1. Section 3 of the said Act No. 22 of 1870-71, shall not apply Repeal of sec. 3 of
Act 22 of 1870-71.
to any company or copartnership formed or to be formed for the
purpose of carrying on the business of fire or marine insurance:
Provided that this repeal shall not affect any such company already
incorporated under the authority of any Private Act.
